- (9) three words which best describe your veteran

Directions to Six Mile Farm:

From I-270 (N or S), take Exit 22 towards Hyattstown. At the stop sign, turn right onto Rt. 109 South. Travel on Rt. 109 South, also known as Old Hundred Rd, approx 3 miles. Right turn onto Thurston Rd, travel 1 mile. Sharp left turn onto Sugarloaf Mountain Rd, travel 1/3 mile. Left turn at #1349 Sugarloaf Mountain Rd, Dickerson, MD 20842 (green mail box). Travel back long driveway to white bankbarn. If you get lost, call Penny at 301-908-5400 for directions.

From I-70 (N or S), take Exit 62 (MD-75S) towards Monrovia/Hyattstown. Turn left onto MD-75S/Green Valley Rd. At dead end, turn right onto MD-75/Baldwin Rd. After approx 1/2 mile, turn left onto MD-75/Greene Valley Rd. Travel about 2 1/2 miles and make a sharp right onto MD-80/Fingerboard Rd. After almost 3 miles, turn left onto Big Woods Rd. Big Woods Rd becomes Doctor Perry Rd. Travel approx 3 miles and turn left onto Thurston Rd. In a little less than 1 mile, Thurston Rd becomes Sugarloaf Mountain Rd. Left turn at #1349 Sugarloaf Mountain Rd, Dickerson, MD 20842 (green mail box). Travel back long driveway to white bankbarn. If you get lost, call Penny at 301-908-5400 for directions.
